

## 2010 Travis County Medical Alliance Grant Requests

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TCMA is now accepting grant applications for 2010. The TCMA has a long history of service to the Travis County Community, part of whom has been to grant money to many Travis County health-related nonprofit organizations. Last year, a total of \$27,500 in grants was allocated to selected organizations. TCMA will again be allocating funds to numerous grants in 2010.

The TCMA Grant criteria is listed below.

Any organization submitting a proposal for review must:

1. Be an established nonprofit with 501(c)(3) status. Clean financial review essential, audit preferred.
2. Be a healthcare related project. Projects which provide/support direct patient care preferred.
3. Be a project which involves Alliance or Society membership.
4. Submit an itemized budget. If your proposal is chosen, your organization must agree to sequester Alliance funds for the proposal's purpose. A general Alliance policy is that we do not underwrite salaries.
5. Agree to provide the Alliance with project and financial update on semi-annual basis until all Alliance funds are disbursed.
6. Agree to allow the Alliance to conduct a site visit and to request additional information.
7. Include Alliance support in all appropriate publicity. Alliance must be acknowledged in annual reports and on any other community donor lists.

Preference is given to those projects that provide or support direct patient care. If you know of an organization or project which meets these criteria and is interested in applying for a TCMA grant, please contact Heather Fagin DDS. **Applications are due by Friday August 14, 2009.**
